Noun Endings /s/, /z/, and /ɪz/

Regular plural nouns end in -s or -es. Practice the three ending sounds with your teacher: /s/, /z/, and /ɪz/.

Singular Plural: Voiceless /s/

bat	bats
book	books
duck	ducks
map	maps
cuff	cuffs

Singular Plural: Voiced /z/

bowl	bowls
bed	beds
pen	pens
tie	ties
pig	pigs
card	cards

Singular Plural: Extra syllable /ɪz/

horse	horses
box	boxes
watch	watches
dish	dishes

Possessive nouns end in 's. Practice the three ending sounds with your teacher.
